

OFFICIAL STATEMENT

No. 193/BNDCC/IX/17

Bali Nusa Dua Convention Center (BNDCC) is located in the premier resort area of Nusa Dua, in the southeast of Bali. Nusa Dua is positioned approximately 80 Km away from Mount Agung.

Mount Agung has been experiencing higher levels of volcanic activity since last Friday. BNPB (the Indonesia National Disaster Agency) has issued a statement today stating that the movement of magma to the surface is also increasing. This is indicated by the increased frequency of deep volcanic earthquakes, shallow volcanic earthquakes and local tectonic earthquakes.

A spokesperson from BNPB also said: "There is a definite possibility that it will erupt, however we don't know when it will happen."

According to the PVMBG (the Indonesia Centre of Volcanology and Geological Hazard Mitigation), should Mount Agung erupt, the impact could potentially spread across a 12 Km radius, however the estimated danger zones are dynamic, and subject to change depending on the scale of the eruption.
